Secured ACT Government funding to offer wearable contact tracing technology free-of-charge to meeting planners holding an event in Canberra



Business Events Bid Fund

Secured ACT Government funding to roll out and administer the Business Events Bid Fund, offering cash incentives to meeting planners to bring new business to Canberra
